Dear Patient,

We are posting these labs for you in order that you may have them for your records; or if needed, for you to print and send them to other doctors. It is our policy to request that you schedule a follow-up visit for discussion of labs if you have any questions.

You may have labs that fall “outside the normal range”. This does not mean, however, that there is a problem. Significant problems are caught when we review all the labs as they return to our office. In the case of medically urgent labs, we call or otherwise make every effort to contact patients. However, the sheer volume of labs that we perform in our practice prohibits us from calling on every “abnormal” value.

If you have questions about your labs or still feel that an important issue has been overlooked, please schedule a follow-up office visit with one of our practitioners. Please be aware that the nursing staff is generally not qualified to answer clinical questions regarding lab results. If your concern is urgent, office staff will relay your question(s) to the practitioner to determine if action is needed.

In order to serve you better, providing you have had Health Diagnostic Labs performed, we can schedule a follow-up appointment with our Certified Nutritionist. She is qualified to interpret our extensive lipid (cholesterol) panel and assist you in creating a customized diet and lifestyle plan that can help improve your overall quality of life.
